### Publication of PAPs offer for Timetable 2019

Dear Customers, Dear Business Partners,

I am pleased to inform you that the Baltic-Adriatic RFC Pre-arranged Paths (PaPs) offer for TT 2019 has been published.

From **January 8<sup>th</sup>** 2018, you can find the **PaP offer for TT 2019** published in PCS via the following link: <http://pcs.rne.eu>.

In addition to PCS, in order to provide you with general overview of all published PaPs on RFC Baltic Adriatic, a worksheet document is available for download in the section "PAPs TT 2019 offer" of RFC5 website.

**Main novelty** is that all published PaPs are **ExtraFlex** PaPs. This is a new concept that RFC Baltic Adriatic decided to offer its customers to provide them with an extra flexibility compared to the Flex PaP approach. It means that when submitting a request for capacity by **April 9<sup>th</sup>** 2018 by using PCS as the unique booking tool, you will be able to ask for custom timetable not only at origin/destination and intermediate stations but also at some border points within a bandwidth of the originally published PaP.

Please refer to RFC5 CID **Book IV** for detailed information about the borders and their bandwidth range and for information about procedures for requesting capacity and allocation conditions via the Corridor One-Stop-Shop (please download the updated version from Documents section).

The C-OSS will submit the Draft Offer on **July 2<sup>nd</sup>** and the final offer on **August 20<sup>th</sup>** 2018.
